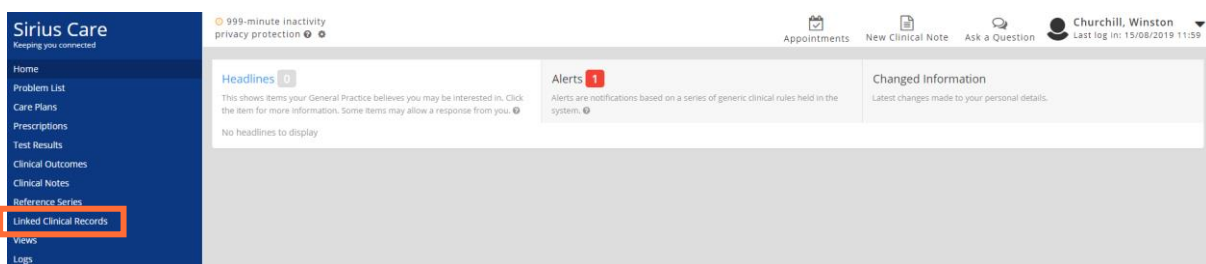
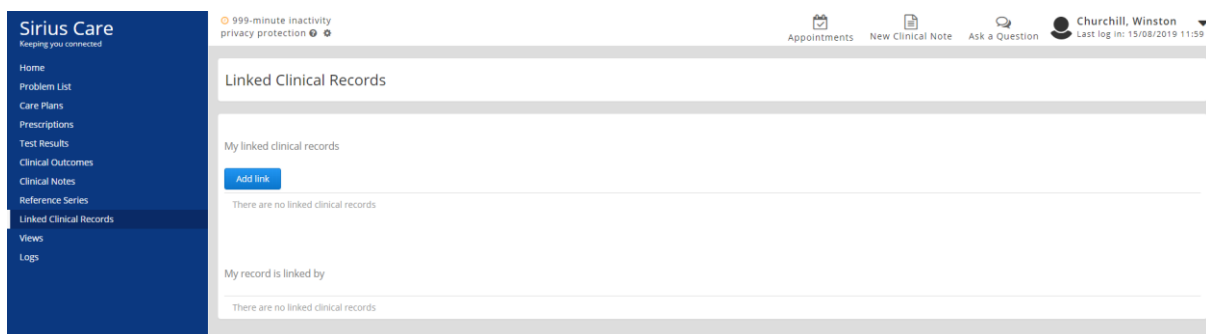


How to link clinical records

- Note: The patient whose clinical record you wish to link must be with you, and/or able to provide their username and password for this to be completed.
- As the Patient who wishes to be able to view another patient's record from whom you have permission to do so, you need to first access Sirius Care via your **General Practice website**.
- Enter your **username** and **password**. You will reach the Sirius Care landing page.



- Click on the 'Linked Clinical Records' area.



- Click **Add link**, the patient whose clinical records you wish to link to and view, now needs to enter their **username** and **password**
